## **Afghan Crises Appeal** **OUR PARISH HAS PLEDGED £1000**

I do hope you and your families had a joyous Christmas and a peaceful and blessed New Year and that the gift of faith within us all has continued to keep us strong and resilient during another Christmas when we were burdened by Coronavirus. We pray that 2022 will be a year where we face less challenges and are able to come together more as a Parish family.

Although we all face difficulties in our lives, we must also see the greater challenges of others and reflect on what the people of Afghanistan are facing at this time of year. A harsh winter has set in, and millions of people are unable to feed themselves daily. Whole regions are on the brink of famine. Millions have fled their homes, the overwhelming majority women and children. Temperatures usually reach -12°C in Afghan winters.

We are so very fortunate in our parish. We have so many generous people and you have supported causes such as this in so many ways and over so many years. I thank you for the immense compassion you have always shown, even when you have faced your own suffering.

Our 50/50 Club, which we launched in 2019, has been incredibly successful and we have had lots of fun drawing out winning numbers at our gatherings after Mass. I thank you for renewing your membership each year and being a part of this club and we look forward to giving out many more prizes over the coming months. As you know 50% of all the money we receive goes towards our prizes each month and 50% goes towards Parish funds. Given the struggles in Afghanistan, I would like to pledge £1000 from Parish funds, generated from our 50/50 Club, to this worthy cause. I want to say a huge thank you to you for enabling our Parish to send this sum of money, in the hope that we can in some way alleviate the terrible suffering of those much less fortunate than ourselves. This money will provide food, clean water, and winter fuel to vulnerable families.
